**Notes on Today's Music.** Franz Peter Schubert was a prolific Austrian composer. In a short lifespan of less than 32 years, he wrote some 600 Lieder, nine symphonies (including the famous "Unfinished Symphony"), liturgical music, operas, some incidental music and a large body of chamber and solo piano music.
